Day1: Arrival Lod to Caesarea-Haifa

Leave the airport to Caesarea: Roman theatre and aqueduct, continue to Haifa, visit Mount Carmel for a panoramic view of the city and Harbor, and visit the church of Stella Maris.

Dinner and overnight in Nazareth

Day 2: Nazareth - Tiberius

Visit the church of annunciation in Nazareth, continue to Cana of the Galilee where Jesus performed his first public miracle, the turning of a large quantity of water into wine at a wedding feast. Visit Tiberius, church of the loaves and fishes, the church of the primacy of St.

Peter, mount of Beatitudes, Capernaum ,enjoy a boat ride on the sea of Galilee, visit the Jordan river before driving to Jenin for dinner and overnight.

Day 3: Nablus and Ramallah

Leave at the early morning to Nablus as we'll start with a visit to Sebastia, the ancient site of Samaria-Sebastia is located just above the built up area of the modern day village on the eastern slope of the hill. The ruins dominate the hillside and comprise remains from six successive cultures dating back 10,000 years: Canaanite, Israelite, Hellenistic, Herodias, roman and through to the Crusader, Maluku and Ottoman empires.

Head to explore Ramallah, the modern, vibrant, cultural capital of the west bank. Where we'll walk through the city and visit Arafat's Tomb. Dinner and overnight in Ramallah.

Day 4: Jericho-Dead Sea

Drive to wade Qelt, continue to Jericho the oldest town in the world. See the mount of temptation and the location of the Sycamore tree that Zacchaeus climbed. Visit Qasser el yahud- the Baptismal site, have a swim in the therapeutic waters of the Dead Sea.

Overnight in Jericho.



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Day 5: Jerusalem

After breakfast drive to Jerusalem. We go to the Mount of Olives and start from there the "Via Dolorosa" which is a street, in two parts, within the Old City of Jerusalem, held to be the path that Jesus walked, carrying his cross, on the way to his crucifixion, and ultimately, his bodily resurrection from the dead three days later. In our way we will visit 14 station of the cross of Jesus such as the Church of the Holy Face, and Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 6: Jerusalem

Visit the Dome of the rock, al Aqsa mosque. Having a Palestinian traditional lunch in the old city of Jerusalem. Leave to Bethlehem and sleep there.

Day 7: Bethlehem-Hebron

Leave to visit the shepherds field, visit the Church of Nativity where Jesus was born, drive to visit the Solomon's pools, then we will continue to Hebron, visit the old city and Abraham mosque-the tomb of the patriarchs, walk in the old city of Hebron. Back to Bethlehem for overnight.

Day 8: Leave to lod airport.
